From Brandenburg Gate to Eagles Nest!



Day 1 June 16th 2027

Arrive at Berlin – the capital city of Germany and historically so connected with the USA. We will transfer you to your centrally located hotel where you can get settled, take a walk and later join our welcome meeting, get to know your tour guides and have dinner. (D)



Day 2 June 17th 2028

Our morning sightseeing tour gives you a first impression of the „new and former“ capital city of Germany. We stop at the famous BRANDENBURG GATE, the RUSSIAN WAR MEMORIAL, the impressing HOLOCAUST MEMORIAL and the bombed out ruins of the MEMORIAL CHURCH. Here in the very center of the city we let you go to have lunchtime on your own. Spend the

afternoon either with own activities or join our ***optional excursion „WW II – beginning and end at Berlin“***. Overnight at your Berlin hotel. (B)

Day 3 June 18th 2028



We take you to LEIPZIG TODAY where during the times of former EAST GERMANY a liberation movement started that finally liberated the East and caused the reunited Germany. We also see the famous St. Thomas Church where the composer J.S. Bach worked.



Our final destination is Dresden, historic city of stunning baroque architecture. After a walking tour with a local historian spend some time on your own at the historic center. Included dinner at the hotel. (B, D)

Day 4

June 19th, 2027

On our drive to Nuremberg we take a brief stop at Richard Wagners Opera House in the city of Bayreuth and then continue to Nuremberg, famous for



The Nuremberg Trials - which were to bring the German crimes committed during World War II to justice.



On November 20, 1945, for the first time in world history, leading representatives of a state had to answer for their crimes before an international court. On this day, the "Major War Criminals Trial" – initiated by the U.S. - against 21 high-ranking representatives of the Nazi state opened at the Palace of Justice in Nuremberg.



Visit the exhibition in the historic Court building and take a look into the famous Room 600 where US „Justice Jackson“ interrogated the Top Nazis.

We also visit St. Sebaldus Church, almost destroyed in WW II, later rebuilt and today holding the famous Cross of Nails, gifted by the British Coventry Cathedral which was heavily bombed by the Nazis in 1940.

The next WWII highlight is “Soldiers Field” , the Nazi Party Rallye Grounds, where during the Nazi Regime Hitler took the parades of thousands of soldiers under a gigantic swastika.

Tonight enjoy an included Bratwurst Dinner at a restaurant which was a historic hospital and pharmacy in the Middle Ages.

Overnight Nuremberg (B,D)

Day 5

June 20th, 2027



Leave Nuremberg on a day tour for the medieval city of *Rothenburg* – one of the most beautiful historic cities with cobblestone lanes and 16th century houses – and a great place for shopping - especially for Christmas Ornaments. Here you'll find half-timbered houses and a medieval fortification wall 2 miles long and cobblestone streets.

On the way back to Nuremberg you will travel on the famous *Romantic Road*, passing farms, meadows, forests and quaint villages before coming back to Nuremberg.

Day 6

June 21st, 2027



Today visit Munich – the capital city of Bavaria. In a suburb we stop at the gigantic castle „Nymphenburg“, the summer residence of the Royal Family of Bavaria since 1675.

Next enjoy a visit to „BMW WORLD“ to admire German cars.

A walking tour of the center of Munich displays the main sights of the rise of the Nazi Party, because Munich was her birthplace. We stop at the „Fuehrerbau“ – once Hitler's Personal Headquarter, where the famous „Munich Agreement“ was signed, and the famous „Festsaal“ at the beerhall HOFBRAUHAUS, where Hitler spoke to hundreds of Nazi-Party enthusiasts.

This late afternoon have some time for shopping before we meet to drive to Schwangau, a little village right below the famous fairy tale castle

Day 7

June 22nd, 2027



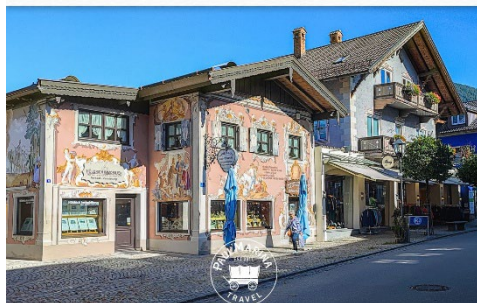
